



Walk Day Directions:

From the North or South (Westchester, Putnam & Dutchess County):

Take the Taconic State Parkway to the Franklin D. Roosevelt State Park exit. The Park exit is between the Baldwin Road exit and Route 202. Please note that buses and commercial vehicles are prohibited on the Taconic.

From the West (Bear Mountain):

Cross the Bear Mountain Bridge and follow the Bear Mountain Parkway East to the exit for Route 202 East. Take Route 202 East approximately 2.5 miles to the Taconic State Parkway South. Take the Taconic State Parkway to the first exit for Franklin D. Roosevelt State Park. Please note that buses and commercial vehicles are prohibited on the Taconic.

From Route 684 (Fairfield CT, Eastern Westchester & Putnam Counties):

Take 684 to Exit 6 (Katonah/Cross River). Proceed on Route 35 West to Route 202 West. Follow Route 202 West approximately 2.5 miles to the Franklin D. Roosevelt State Park entrance on your left.

There is a \$6.00 per car entrance fee charged by the Park. Please let the attendant know that you are participating in the CCF Walk. CCF will be billed by the Park for the total entrance fees after the completion of the event.

Once you are inside the Park, follow the CCF Teddy Bear Signs to the Walk Area. We will be located by the Pool Parking Area.

The Walk is held Rain or Shine!

At the Walk Site:

Team members; gather with your Team Captain for Registration. Individuals (not a member of a Team), proceed to the registration table.

Registration is from 9 – 10 AM.

Andy Bale, The Walk Grand Marshal and the Poster Children will cut the ribbon and kick-off the Walk at 10 AM Sharp!

The Walk Route is a three mile loop through FDR State Park. There is a paved section and a wooded, dirt path section. The complete loop is well marked. Walkers may complete the entire loop or return to the picnic area via the paved roadway. Following the Walk, our very generous sponsors, McDonald's of Yorktown and Pepsi, provide lunch & refreshments.

There are restroom facilities located within the Park and specifically next to the Walk Area.
